Available for households with K-12 or college students; limited to new accounts who do not already have a Spectrum Internet subscription; installation fees will be waived and Spectrum WiFi hotspots will be open for public use.

International Calls

Verizon will offer free international calling to countries identified by the Center for Disease Control as [Level 3 impacted](#) by the coronavirus effective 3/18 through the end of April. This is available to wireless postpaid consumer and small/medium business customers, and landline home phone customers. Unlimited calls will be included to mobile and landline termination, except for Iran, Latvia, Lithuania and Slovenia, which will be provided 300 minutes of free calls per month. Effective 3/19, wireless prepaid customers will also receive a total of 300 additional minutes to call level 3 countries.

Verizon will also waive activation fees on new lines of service and upgrade fees starting March 18. This applies to all purchases and service-only activations made through Verizon digital channels, such as [verizonwireless.com](#) and the My Verizon app.
